Ours is a relationship centered, play based philosophy where each teacher is a primary caregiver for approximately 4 children. Five full days per week, children participate in a variety of activities that encourage their development in each of the developmental domains. We are looking for a teacher with a strong background caring for young children to join our wonderful team! The ideal candidate takes initiative, is reliable, outgoing, and friendly.

Teachers receive paid planning time each week, financial support for attending professional development and/or college coursework throughout the year, weekly reflective practice, as well as built in, paid professional development and in-service days each month.

The open Teacher position is full time Monday through Friday and will be eligible for medical/dental benefits, 403b Retirement Plan, as well as paid vacation and sick time.

## **Requirements:**

At least 12 units of ECE including 3 infant/toddler units

Must pass Live Scan criminal background check/fingerprinting as well as a pre-employment health screening including negative TB test and proof of immunity to Measles, Pertussis, and Flu (per licensing requirements).

A candidate who is bilingual English/Spanish is preferred but not required.
