

How Transition House Works

We believe that every family, no matter how or why they became homeless, deserves the chance to escape poverty and learn the skills they need to increase their income, manage their money, and return to their own housing. We do this by providing intensive case management and employment services that focus on setting and achieving goals that will help stabilize the family, and promote financial and emotional wellbeing. We also provide children's programs that address the trauma young people are experiencing and help teach them tools for a successful future.

Three-Stage Family Housing Continuum with Support Services

The first stage begins with a three to five month stay at our 70-bed emergency shelter. At the shelter, families recover from crisis, establish realistic income and savings goals with the help of a case manager, find or improve employment income, and come up with a housing plan. Some families may move to the second stage which offers six months of transitional housing at our facility called the Firehouse for up to six families at a time. Eligible families with high barriers to stability may then continue to our third stage program, HOMES, where they can live for up to two years or more in one of thirtyseven Transition House-owned affordable apartments with supportive services.

Anti-Poverty Classes

Parents in our programs attend onsite anti-poverty classes, which are also available to people in the community who are at risk of losing their housing. Classes cover topics such as ESL, financial literacy, computer skills, and parenting. Our computer lab works to address digital inequities homeless families often experience.

Children's Programs

Homeless and low-income families can receive free or subsidized care through our onsite licensed Infant Care Center, School children participate in evening enrichment programs—including a literacy program and tutoring help—that aim to break the cycle of generational poverty for children who are at highest

We Did It!

he year 2022 saw Transition House bring back programs and volunteers as we returned to regular, prepandemic operations. We've been incredibily lucky—while many businesses and nonprofits lost income,



staff, or support as the result of the pandemic, largely, we did not. Yes, we did take on the cost of paying for what volunteers provided to our operations in the past, in particular in the shelter dinner service arena, but many of these groups subsidized our efforts with donations until they could eventually return to serve in person. Although we lost one fifth of our dinner provider groups plus some of our regular program volunteers, we kept enough of a base to allow us to build back the volunteer support that we rely on to operate efficiently and successfully.

In the meantime, the rental housing landscape changed significantly in 2022, and not in a good way. From 2021 to 2022, the already high cost of rental housing in Santa Barbara exploded, and the average cost of a two-bedroom apartment went from \$2,748 to \$3,687 a month. The vast majority of our clients do not make enough to afford rent this high, let alone also pay for food, clothing, transportation, and other expenses.

We have really been struggling with this reality. We have continued to successfully place families in housing, but almost half of those families end up in shared housing situations. Very few find affordable or subsidized housing units for rent because there are too few units to satisfy the need.

We are continuing to focus on our programs that provide families the tools to increase their income and manage their finances, because that is what we do best. Transition House will also continue to explore opportunities to develop more affordable transitional or permanent housing in the future.

We are extremely grateful for the support you have provided to Transition House, and for the faith you had in our staff and our board members to do what was necessary to navigate the ups and downs of the pandemic. Together, we did it!

500 VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers returned to most of our programs in 2022 and for that we are very grateful!



72% SUCCESS RATE

The majority of families succeed in transitioning to stable housing.

Nearly all parents gained, maintained, or increased employment income while in our program.

The vast majority of shelter families came from the Santa Barbara, Goleta, and Carpinteria areas. Five percent came from Lompoc/Santa Maria and three percent were from Ventura.



\$3,239 SAVINGS

On average, families saved this amount toward move-in costs.



252 CHILDREN

Children from the shelter, our other housing locations, and from the community participated in a variety of our programs.

Transition House's target population is homeless families with children, and households at high risk for homelessness, within the greater Santa Barbara area.

Total clients served in the shelter in 2022:

259 individuals (81 families). Of those: 61 percent children; 71 percent single-parent families; 11 percent chronically homeless; 51 percent homeless for the first time.

Of all adults, 55 percent had experienced past domestic violence; 46 percent were experiencing mental illness; 40 percent were working to overcome an addiction; and 27 percent of adults had one or more disabilities. 67 percent of adults graduated from high school; 18 percent attended some college.

Racial/Ethnic make-up: African American 2 percent; White non-Hispanic 15 percent; Hispanic 79 percent; Native American 1 percent; Asian 1 percent; other 2 percent.

Transition House served an additional 149 people in our second and third stage housing programs last year.

He had a tough time speaking out and feeling heard, but he remembers feeling cared for and listened to by volunteers and staff working in our children's programs. Manny now works with shelter children and provides the same thoughtful care shown to him at an early age. Being a good listener to these youngsters is what they need, and it truly gives him a sense of purpose to give back.

Arianna also works in our children's programs. She came to the shelter when she was only eight years old. She

loves the program and can see now how much it helps parents—she wasn't aware of that when she was young.

Today, Arianna loves working with the kids and has a strong understanding of what they are going through. She helps them to deal with the challenges of being homeless—those same challenges she experienced.

Patricia's Story

Patricia is currently the overnight manager at Transition House's shelter and is responsible for the wellbeing of all our residents until the morning. Patricia was a resident of Transition House in 2020 with her four children. She became homeless as a result of a divorce and she had no other family to help her at the time. It was really hard—the rules and the schedule—especially for the children. But while she was in the shelter, she finally started to

believe in herself and realized that she was lucky to get out of a bad situation. Working two jobs and saving all the money she could, Patricia was determined to succeed. After three months in the shelter, her family moved to our second stage transitional housing. Patricia did so well that she qualified for one of our apartments three months later and she still lives there.

Patricia has worked at Transition House for a year and a half. She likes working in the shelter because she can relate to what clients are going through. She enjoys listening to client stories. Sometimes a client comes in late from a job or is up in the middle of the night, unable to sleep and Patricia is there to listen, to make them tea, or help them if they have things like laundry they need to get done. She'll even cook something special for them!

Patricia appreciates Transition House's program. Because staying in the shelter was free, she was able to save a lot of money while she was a resident. Her case managers helped her to define her goals and kept her motivated.

Patricia is grateful for the support of the community. Thanks to all of you, Patricia and her children have a safe place to call home.
